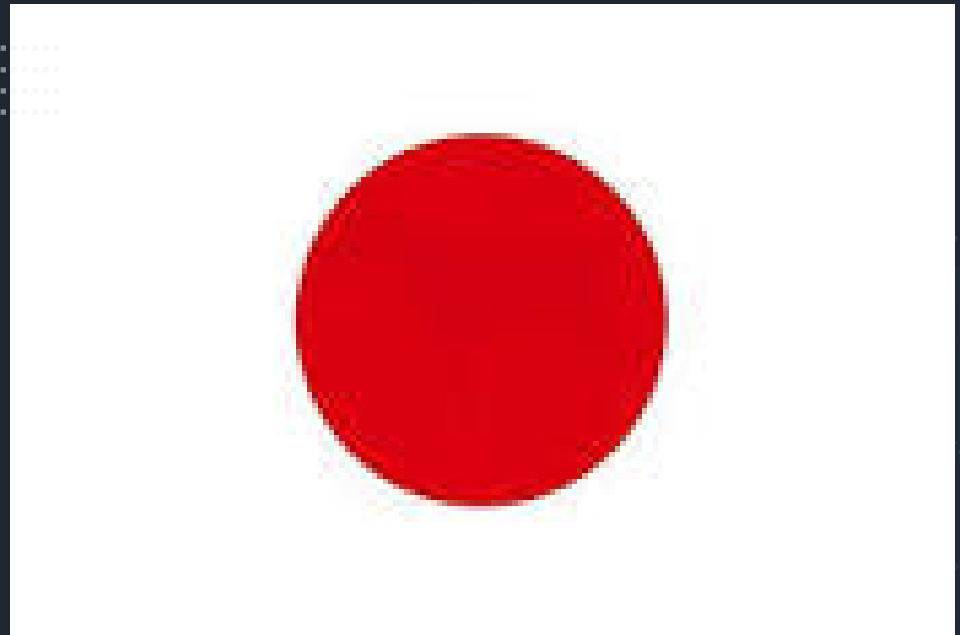


The ushers will show

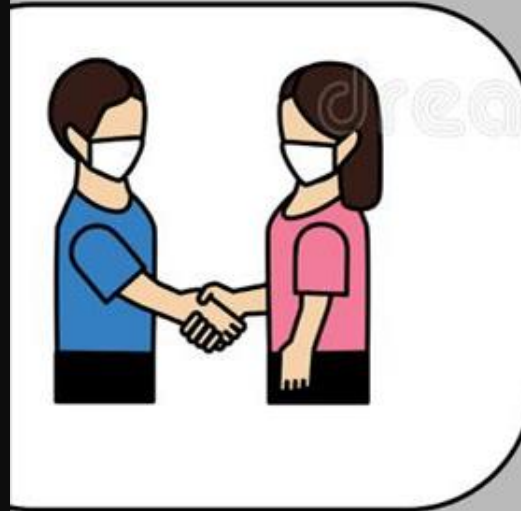


You will sit in spots

## KEEP SAFE DISTANCE



All should line up when receiving Communion, for those not receiving Communion, place your arms across your chest to receive a blessing. Follow ushers' instructions. Wear your mask. After taking communion in your hand, please step to the side on the adjacent floor decal, lower your mask and ingest the host. Precious blood of Christ will not be offered.
